Grant Agreement With:

Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development
Harrisburg, PA

Purpose:

To apply for grant funding to support costs of conducting elections in accordance with Act 88 of 2022 (SB 982 as enacted) for the 2022 General Election and 2023 Municipal Primary. And authorize the County Chief Clerk, Chief Registrar of Elections and/or County Commissioners to sign grant application documents per grant requirements.

Amount/Term:

Per Act 88, counties are eligible to receive funding on an annual basis through a grant application process. Applications are due by August 15. Estimated amount Lancaster County may be eligible to receive in 2022 is \$1,781,506.00.

Funding:

100% State funding.
